- Must run programs during each session in Fall, Spring, Summer and any additional camps.
- Schedule subject to change including nights and weekends
- Flexibility to work at varying locations
- Demonstrated ability to work independently and creatively
- High standards for excellence and exceptional attention to detail
- Flexibility and a sense of humor
